

A contribution to children's leisure activities in Fljótshérað

Rules and conditions

Fljótshérað supports sports- and leisure activities for children between the ages of 4 to 16, with permanent residence in the municipality, with a contribution in the amount of 30.000 kr. in 2020.

The contribution's goal is to encourage children to take part in organized and healthy sport- and leisure activities, independent of economic or social circumstances.

Organized sport or leisure activities are those that cover at least 10 weeks combined and are under the leadership of qualified teachers/coaches/staff. Also arranged by acknowledged clubs, associations, businesses or schools which undertake such operations.

The contribution is not valid as payment for facilities, travels or other costs that might arise because of training or competitions. Also, it is not valid as a payment for sports practiced on one's own, e.g. for memberships to a gym or swimming pool, where there are no organized activities.

There are no direct payments, but parents and guardians have the right to dispose of a specified amount in the name of their child for reimbursement of participation and training fees.

- Subscribers are registered in the Nóra system through the municipality's website.
- During the registration process you can choose to use the contribution electronically with the partner/department/company concerned.
- You cannot allocate a higher amount than the cost of the course. If the amount of the course is higher than the measure, the difference is paid to the company.
- When a child's participation is confirmed, the relevant club/department/company and Fljótshérað receive confirmation.
- Fljótshérað will pay the leisure contribution to the relevant sports club/department/company at the beginning of each month.
- In a receipt to participants about course costs, a company must specify the municipality's share of the course fee payment.
- Unused contributions do not move/is not stored between years and can only be used in the year 2020.

Those children who live 5 km or more away from the municipal boundaries receive an annual grant of ISK 5,000 to meet the cost of driving. To apply for this grant, you must fill out an application form on the Fljótshérað website.

If any debatable questions arise the committee for sports and leisure will decide on the matter. The contribution is under the supervision of the project manager for sports and leisure, who answers all end every question.

The council decides on the amount and administration of the contribution for each year.
